Meet the Wheelers

I was born in Detroit, Michigan where I attended the Redford Church of Christ. It was there that I met my wife, Renee. We have been blessed with three children, Trevor, Trisha, and Troy.

In 1980, Renee and I made our first mission trip to Ghana, West Africa and our lives have never been the same. By mid-1981, we decided to do full-time missions. Therefore, in January 1982, we moved to Lakeland, Florida where we enrolled in the Florida School of Preaching.

In 1984, we completed our studies and moved to Tema, Ghana - working with the church in Ashaiman which was established in 1982. Over the next five years the church grew to nearly three hundred members, bought seven acres of land, and built their current meeting place. We were also involved in establishing new congregations throughout Ghana. Renee also worked in organizing and teaching Bible classes for ladies and children, as well as teaching primary health care to the ladies. I had the privilege to teach a number of fine men at the National Bible Institute a preacher training school, in Accra. We have also worked in Togo, Senegal, Cote D'Ivoire and Tanzania.

In 1989, we moved home where I have been serving as the minister for the church in Venice, Florida. Renee has worked for Sarasota County Schools working with children with varying exceptionalities. The last two years she has worked with high school students teaching them how to instruct pre-K children. Renee and I have enjoyed being camp counselors for ten years. We have continued to conduct annual campaigns to Ghana. It has been a real blessing to have many of the Cary members work with us on these trips.

As an instructor at the Florida School of Preaching I teach classes in *Missions, Computers & Preaching, The Preacher & His Work*, and other Bible related subjects. At FSOP I have been given the opportunity to train sound preachers, elders and Bible class teachers. Hundreds have graduated from FSOP and are serving the Lord's church throughout the US and in other parts of the world. I also serve as the Chairman of the Board of Directors.

Renee enjoys teaching ladies Bible classes, reading, traveling, decorating, entertaining at home and working with children. I enjoy computers, traveling, boating and fishing, working on cars, and spending time with church members of all ages.
