- Models appropriate Christian behavior
- Ability to teach devotionals, lead prayers and singing
- Strong organizational skills
- Good communication, writing and interpersonal skills
- Connects easily with and enjoys kids
- Social media savvy
- An encourager
- High energy
- Ability to deal with confidential/sensitive information
- Strong leadership presence (when needed)
- Very responsible and dependable
- Ability to deal with conflict (among kids and parents)
- Medium to high attention to detail
- Possess a valid drivers license and be able to drive a passenger van
- Flexible thinker
- Uses a collaborative working style

Responsibilities:

- Ensure all activities are in alignment with the Youth Group Strategies.
- Ensure the physical safety of the kids.
- Organize and conduct devotionals.
- Identify, organize and lead service projects.
- Conduct quarterly parent meetings.
- Find answers to difficult doctrinal questions.
- Coordinate annual youth rally (HS and MS).
- Mentor kids (safe place for them to share feelings).
- Attend monthly Youth Committee meetings.
- Coordinate effectively with members of the Youth Committee and encourage them to participate in youth activities and the Lord's work.
- Obtain approval for activities through the deacon/elders.
- Secure meeting/activity dates on the church calendar.
- Coordinate with the Internal Communications deacon to ensure scheduled activities are communicated through the bulletin and website.
